GDA internship program for 2024 now accepting applications

The Georgia Department of Agriculture is accepting applications to its 2024 Internship Program for college and post-secondary education students from across the state.

The program is open to students enrolled in a post-secondary educational institution in Georgia or who have graduated within one calendar year of the desired internship timeframe. Applications are now being accepted through Feb. 12, 2024, for internships scheduled from May through July.

Students interested in participating in the program can inquire through email using internship@agr.georgia.gov. Complete information about the internship program and application requirements can be found on the GDA website at https://agr.georgia.gov/internship-opportunities.

Summer Williams, GDA's Food Safety Rapid Response Team program manager, and Derrick Lastinger, GDA's Structural Pest Control program director, oversee the Department's internship program.

A general interest in Georgia agriculture is preferred. While an educational background in the study of agriculture is optional, it may be desired for certain available internship op-

Williams explained that the program offers a wide range of experiences across all of GDA's divisions and programs and covers a variety of disciplines in the sciences, administration and communications.

"The Internship Program is an opportunity for students from across the state to join our department for the summer and learn more about what we do in the different divisions," Williams said. "I say even if a student joins to work for one division, they can cross-train and learn about all of the divisions in the Department. I think that is something really special because they are not siloed into doing one specific area of work."

Williams said the program's goals are twofold: To provide an opportunity for students to prepare for work after their studies and to help GDA recruit more students into full-time or part-time positions within the Department.

This year, GDA hosted 10 interns from 50 applications received. Along with working at the Department, the program organizes field trips. Interns will meet Georgia Agriculture Commissioner Tyler Harper and visit the Atlanta State Farmers Market in Forest Park. Interns also will tour the Georgia State

Live Christmas tree maintenance is as easy as adding water

Nothing quite brings in the sight and smell of the season as a live Christmas tree. After you choose your tree and bring it home, it starts drying out, but keeping a steady amount of water in the tree stand will keep it green and healthy through the holiday season.

Chuck Berry of Berry Tree Farm and Nursery in Covington said a tree can drink up to a gallon of water daily. Of the pointers he offers to customers, the one he always starts with is to water the tree daily. The rule of thumb is to ensure there is always enough water in the stand's reservoir to cover the tree's base.

"It's not something you can wait ntil next week to look at it again. It has to be looked at daily," Berry said. "Once that water level gets below the bottom of that trunk, the sap seals back over, and you're back to square one."

Setting up the tree before getting it in the house is important. Berry encourages everyone who buys a live tree to score the bottom of the tree with a serrated knife or small saw. This will break up the sap, which the tree produces to seal any opening.

"I've even told them to scuff the butt of the tree on the concrete driveway just enough to will drink water, but as soon as you do that, you must put it into water or otherwise it will seal back over," Berry said.

A real Christmas tree is best when located in a cool environment. Berry said to consider where you put the tree up, keep it away from a heat source that will dry it out, and avoid the

potential of a fire.

"We encourage them to keep away from heat sources, whether a vent blowing heat on it or a fireplace or near a window that generates a lot of sunlight. All those things generate a lot of heat and dry out the Christmas tree," Berry said.

The Georgia Christmas Tree Association

break up the pores and open up the sap so it (GCTA) offers more advice on tree care. When you decide to get a live tree, before you go to the tree farm, decide how big the tree can be and what type of tree you want. Consider the height added by the angel or star topper and the tree stand.

> Fraser firs are a popular Christmas tree variety, but they do not grow in Georgia, so

> > many tree farms will have them available pre-cut. If you buy a precut tree, cut a little more than half an inch off the bottom to make sure you break through the sap before setting in the stand.

Georgia tree farmers can grow several varieties that differ in size, shape, color and smell. The GCTA website lists tree varieties and their characteristics at https://gacta.com/ types-history/.

Seeing the tree's needles wilt and fall off is a sign of trouble. Berry said that could be the first indicator that the tree is drying out. "

"It's one of those things that when it gets to that point, there's really no way to reverse it," Berry said. "That's why in the study of agriculture is optional, it may be desired for certain taken at the right time in the beginning, so you don't get to that point. If you have a tree that's drinking water and it's in a cooler place in the house, there shouldn't be any issue of a live Christmas tree lasting 3-4 weeks."

Georgie's Drive Thru Cartersville

Hello! I'm Georgie, the Georgia Grown mascot. I travel the state of Georgia promoting our #1 industry, agriculture! Last summer, my family and I traveled up to Louisville, Kentucky, and stopped in Cartersville to pay our respects to one of Ginny's heroes. Born in Virginia, Charlotte Diggs Moon moved to Cartersville after the Civil War to help open the Cartersville Female Academy. Two years later, while a member of Cartersville Baptist Church, she announced her calling to the mission field.

She left her job as a schoolteacher and principal at the academy that fall to serve in China. While there, she survived famines and several conflicts, including the Boxer Rebellion. To help ease the suffering of the people she ministered to, she shared her resources, including her food, at the cost of her own health. Other missionaries discovered her health condition was quickly deteriorating and arranged transportation for her to go home to get medical attention. She died during the trip on Christmas Eve in 1912. In 1918, the Southern Baptist Women's Missionary Union's Christmas fundraising effort for international missions was renamed the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering in her memory.



The Lottie Moon House is located on Cherokee Street in Cartersville. Moon was a member of the Cartersville Baptist Church when she became a missionary and traveled to China. She served there for 39 years and died during a famine in 1912. Today, the Baptist Women's Missionary Union's Christmas fundraising effort is named in her honor. (GDA/Lee Lancaster)

Rocky Road chocolate candy

Ingredients

6 cups miniature marshmallows

1 ½ cups cashews

½ cup freeze-dried strawberries 12 ounces semi-sweet chocolate

1 (14-ounce) can of sweetened condensed milk Pinch of salt

Directions

- 1. Line a 9x13-inch pan with parchment paper. In a large bowl, combine the marshmallows, cashews and strawberries.
- 2. To a medium bowl, combine the chocolate chips, sweetened condensed milk and salt. In a microwave, melt in 30 second intervals, stirring well after each warming, until completely melted.

- 4. Transfer to the fridge to chill for 1 to 2 hours until firm. Slice it up into cubes to serve.

"To everything, there is a season... a time to plant and a time to harvest... a time to be quiet... and a time for peace..." Ecclesiastes 3:1-8.

That bible verse has been written in many different ways and contemplated by hearts and minds throughout the ages. It feels especially meaningful in December. At the Georgia Forestry Commission, gratitude – and trees – are in clear focus throughout our agency during this special season.

December brings cooler temperatures in Georgia and launches the ideal window for planting trees. From Dec. 1 through March 1, rural and urban landowners are urged to choose the right species for the right places and give them solid starts. Geographic location, soil type, sunlight, water, and competition from nearby elements are all part of the formula for healthy outcomes.

Planting trees is one of the easiest and most sustainable ways to positively affect the environment, and there are numerous economic benefits as well. Trees can provide oxygen while storing carbon, provide shelter and habitats for wildlife, and be a renewable income source for landowners. Georgia continues to tackle this season better than any other state,

planting close to 360 million trees annually. The Georgia Forestry Commission provides a wealth of information about planting trees at https://gatrees.org/ and has foresters throughout the state who can offer assistance. For inspiration, our seedling website at https://gaseedlings.

One important delivery in which the GFC is proud to have participated for the past several years is the transportation of the Capitol Christmas tree. On Nov. 14, a Catoosa/

Whitfield counties GFC crew joined forces with teams from the Georgia Building Authority and Premier Tree Service to help harvest a 25-plus-foot red cedar, thought to be about 40 years old. On a special GFC transport, the tree was moved from Whitfield County and escorted by Gerogia State Patrol troopers to the Capitol rotunda in Atlanta. A Whitfield County landowner donated the tree. The landowner would have to remove the tree for its disruption of their home plumbing system, so the tree transfer was surely serendipitous! A Capitol tree lighting ceremony took place during the first week in December.

If your family is looking for a Christmas tree, GFC urges you to think live. There are many Christmas tree farms throughout the state where you can choose your favorite tree and have it bagged for the drive home. See the list here: https://gatrees.org/ directories/christmas-tree-vendor-directory/. Once Christmas has passed, live trees with root balls can be planted and enjoyed for years to come - not just by humans but also by a variety of wildlife. In 2019, Georgia First Lady Marty Kemp and Georgia Grown Executive Chef Holly Chute made this pecan cobbler at the Governor's Mansion and in front of television news cameras. Ingredients

- 6 Tbsps butter
- 2 cups pecans
- 1 tsp cinnamon, split
- 1 ½ cup self-rising flour 1 ½ cup granulated sugar
- 2/3 cup milk
- 1 tsp vanilla

1 ½ cup packed light brown sugar 1 1/2 cup hot water

Instructions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- 2. Add butter to a 9x13 inch cake pan or casserole dish and melt in oven.
- 3. Once butter is melted, sprinkle pecans over butter.
- 4. In a bowl, mix flour, granulated sugar, half a teaspoon cinnamon, milk and vanilla. Stir to combine but do not over-mix.
- 5. Pour batter over butter and pecans, do not mix.
- 6. Combine brown sugar with onequarter to one-half a teaspoon cinnamon.



- 7. Sprinkle brown sugar evenly over batter, do not stir.
- 8. Carefully pour the hot water over the mixture, do not stir.
